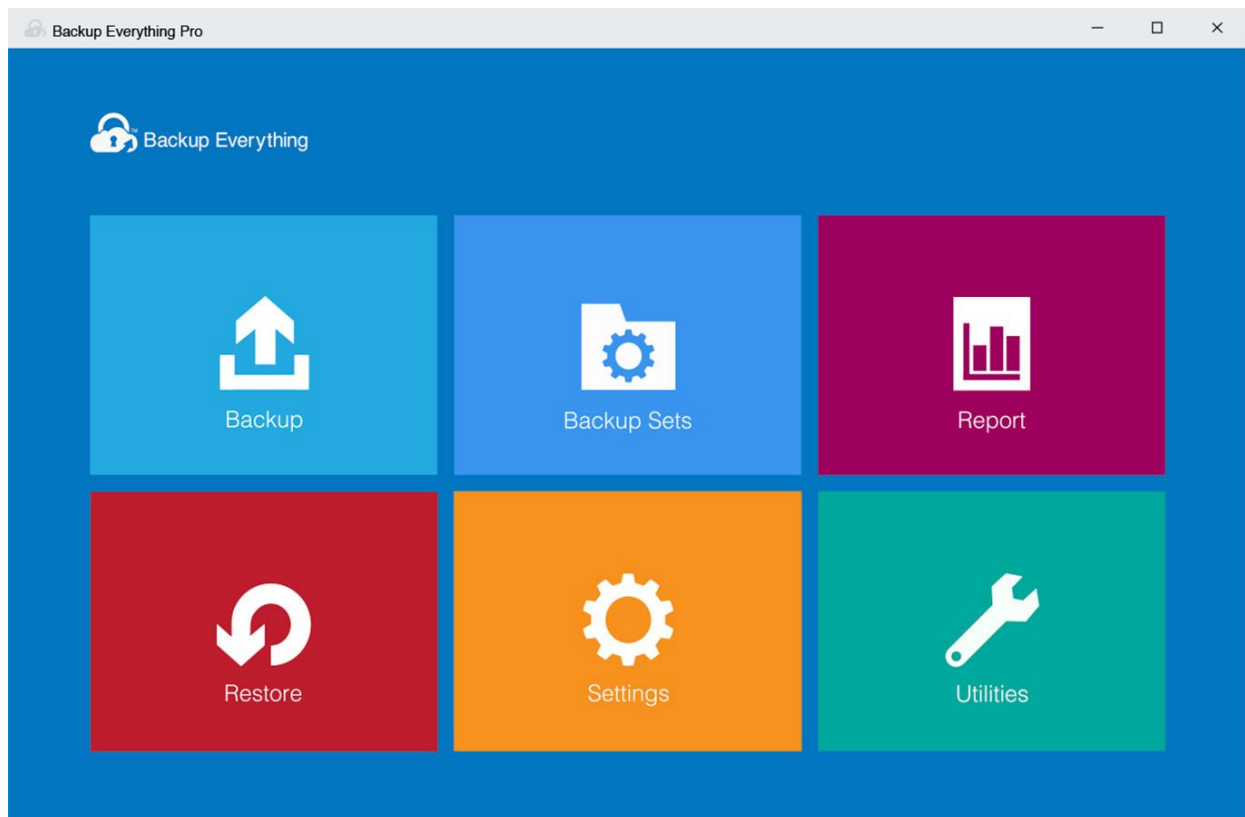


How to Restore a File

If you have managed to delete a file which you need to recover to the exact same location here is how its done:

Step 1.

Log into the backup client and click restore



Step 2.

Click on the backup set you want to restore, ignore the date shown
